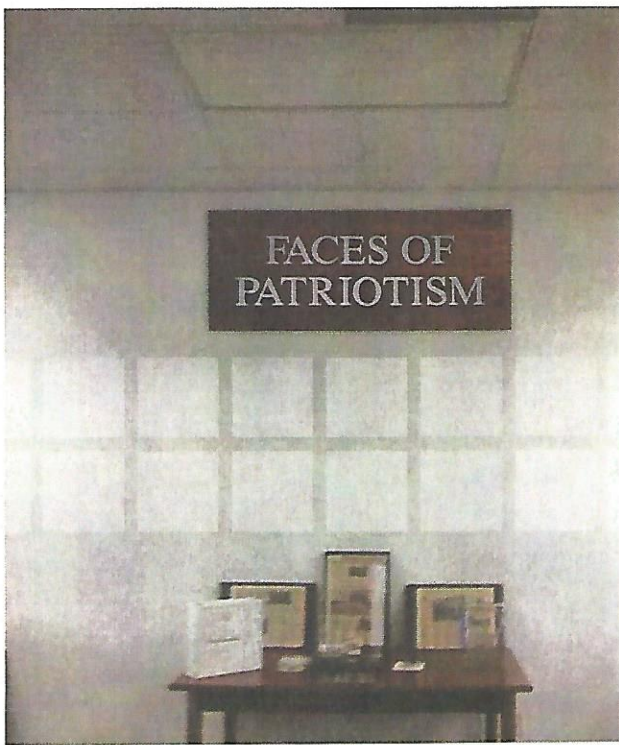

A QUILT comprised of 14 – 12x12 squares representing the 14 cities and jurisdictions involved in the response and rescue will be created as the symbol of "UNITY." We are asking quilters and quilting clubs from the cities of Alma, Brunswick, Darien, Fernandina Beach, Folkston, Hinesville, Jacksonville, Jesup, Kingsland, Savannah, St. Marys, Waycross, Woodbine and Yulee to volunteer their skills and service in crafting these individual squares which will then be joined together into one magnificent quilt depicting how the human spirit overcame devastation.
