THIOKOL MONUMENT



Each year TMP volunteers have been beautifying and cleaning-up the area around the Thiokol Monument located at Maple Ford Park. The flowers, shrubs, and edging plants have not grown and thrived as we had hoped. Camden County PSA has oversight of the Park and has recently renovated the park's facilities. We've met with PSA and we have jointly formulating a plan to resolve the following issues:

- Visibility of the Monument
- Beautification and Clean-up of the Monument Area
- Poor growth of flowers and shrubs
- Seating area near the Monument

We have selected an area to relocate the monument which provides high visibility and the necessary sunlight for plants to thrive. New signage for Maple Ford Park with the Thiokol Monument annotated will be installed to make locating the monument easier. The selected area will be landscaped and park benches will be installed. For this to happen we must gain the permission of the original monument erecting committee, Camden Memorial Service Center, INC and current community oversight organization - North Camden Action Association. We are currently speaking with these committees in an effort to gain their approval.
